## Hispanic Contractors Association de Tejas

The Hispanic Contractors Association De Tejas (HCAT) was formed in 1997 to address the needs of one of the fastest growing sectors of the construction industry. HCAT is a member driven organization that promotes and enhances commerce, trade and contracting opportunities for the benefit of Hispanic Contractors. In addition in giving voice to the business and political concerns of its members, Hispanic Contractors Association De Tejas serves the community through its outreach programs. The organization has Associations through the state of Texas and represents more than 5,000 Hispanic contractors in Texas and is committed to developing programs and facilitating the resources needed to help Hispanic Contractors reach their potential. The HCAT members are directly responsible for over a Billion dollars in construction revenue in the State of Texas.

HCAT participates in various safety venues including an established HCA Safety Committee that participates in the USHCA, Safety Alliances with OSHA, QUION, ABC, TEEX, Richland College and the Austin General Mexican Consulate; the HCAT Continuing Education Program where monthly Safety Training and Courses are delivered and in addition the OSHA 10 Hour Marathon program carried out once, twice and if possible three times a year.

In 2005, HCA-DFW was awarded Susan B. Harwood grant # 46F5-HT03 to develop Focus Four training materials for the construction industry. To date, HCAT has developed 8 computers based training programs, 9 PowerPoint presentation training modules, and a bilingual training book. HCAT has successfully worked about 10 (ten) Susan B. Harwood grants in the past. All grant reports and documentation was completed on time and on budget with no delays. In 2010, HCAT was awarded a four-year capacity building Susan Harwood Grant this was used to expand the organizations' safety training programs and awareness of job site safety concerns within the construction industry and to specifically address the safety concerns facing Spanish-speaking Hispanic workers through the creation of a Construction Compliance Training Center (CCTC). In April 2014, CCTC was opened in Balch Springs, TX to train, educate and address occupational safety and health problems within the construction industry.

HCAT in conjunction with OSHA Region VI and Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) and The University of Texas at Arlington, Region VI OSHA Education Center have hosted 1-day OSHA 10-hour Construction Safety Trainings under HCAT's OSHA 10hr Marathon Program throughout OSHA Region VI, averaging 300 participants each marathon. From our initial OSHA 10 Hour Marathon in 2006, there have been 17 marathons and as a result, over 5,848 construction workers (62% Hispanic) have participated and received the OSHA 10-Hour Outreach Card. That is an outstanding number of workers that are now trained in safety for the construction industry in the State of Texas and OSHA Region VI, and saving the construction industry more than \$1 million by offering the training at a nominal cost.


